JOSEPH BATH MERIT SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES
GRACE COMMUNITY CHURCH

Candidates must comply with the following:

1. The candidate must be a member of Grace Community Church and have been so for at least one (1) year at the time of application.
2. The candidate **must** be or have been actively involved and participating in Grace Community Church and other service oriented organizations. At least forty (40) hours of participation and/or volunteer hours per year at our church is required. This requirement applies to both the Junior and Senior years of a candidate's high school tenure. Ideally, a candidate will satisfy this requirement throughout each of their high school years.
3. The candidate must be completing his or her last semester of high school and will be attending a four (4) year accredited college or university.
4. The candidate must have a 3.5 GPA (grade point average) or higher in academic courses and be a student in good standing with his/her institution of higher learning and must maintain this GPA throughout the term of the award.
5. The candidate must meet the application deadline of April 1st of each year and complete a mandatory interview with the Scholarship Committee. In addition, recipients are encouraged to attend Scholarship Sunday to receive the award.
6. A recipient must carry a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours per semester at an accredited four (4) year college or university throughout the term of the award.
7. The candidate will receive an amount that will be determined annually. That stipend will be given for eight (8) consecutive semesters. Additional administrative requirements, which must be met, will be outlined upon receipt of the scholarship.
8. The recipient must remain a Grace Community Church member during the scholarship period unless the student has become a member of a church in close proximity to the college/university being attended.
